The Sunshine Cart provides a wide variety of personal care products and other items such as notebooks, pens and pencils, puzzle books and some basic clothing items. The Sunshine cart is particularly important to those residents who are not able to go out on shopping trips as it allows them a shopping experience at no cost. The following is a list of items that we carry on the sunshine cart as well as items that are needed on a regular basis. The needs change from week to week so we suggest calling before shopping. (See information below)

- ❖ Toothpaste
- ❖ Toothbrushes - regular and denture
- ❖ Denture cleaning tablets
- ❖ Denture adhesive such as Fixodent
- ❖ Stick deodorant for both men and women
- ❖ Hair combs and brushes
- ❖ Pre-shave (for electric razors, alcohol is ok for this as it is kept in locked cabinet)
- ❖ Emery boards
- ❖ **Alcohol free** mouthwash
- ❖ Kleenex tissues (plus lotion brand is nice)
- ❖ Baby body lotion
- ❖ Shampoo, Dandruff/dry scalp shampoo, baby shampoo
- ❖ Hair Conditioner
- ❖ Body Wash for both men and women
- ❖ Lip balm/Chap stick
- ❖ Individually packaged eyeglass cleaner wipes
- ❖ Large print crossword puzzle, word find or Sudoku books
- ❖ White hankies
- ❖ White Tee-shirts
- ❖ Men's underwear (tighty whities)
- ❖ Postage Stamps

A few helpful Guidelines when purchasing donations:

- ❖ Residents prefer standard size products that can be used for an extended period.
We do not stock travel size items on the Sunshine Cart.
- ❖ Unsafe items such as; liquids containing alcohol, aerosol sprays, medical items, Q-Tips, powder (of any kind) or food products are not accepted.
- ❖ We have received a lot of 3-1 (shampoo, conditioner and body wash) which the residents don't like to use so we are currently asking to avoid purchasing it.
